Do you qualify?

Identify as a member of the LGBTQ+ community (publicly or privately), have lived in California for at least one year, and are one of the following:

- □ High school senior
- ☐ Incoming and current college or university student
- □ Current community college student
- □ Adult re-entry student

Demonstrate financial need by completing one of these items:

- ☐ Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- ☐ The California DREAM Act Application
- ☐ The Federal Student Aid Estimator Tool

Plan to enroll in at least 6 units in a:

- ☐ Title IV-approved and accredited public or nonprofit community college
- ☐ Four-year university
- ☐ Trade/vocational school in the United States

Application period is from January 15 - March 5, 2025.
