#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 6.4%** since 2013, growing by 243,361. Population is expected to **increase by 4.1%** between 2018 and 2023, adding 166,796.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 14.5% in 4 California Counties from 1,533,470 to 1,755,237. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 8.5% by 6.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.7% to 59.8% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, 22.2% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (3.6% above the national average), and 7.8% hold an Associate's Degree (0.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.





#### **Job Trends**














### **Top Growing Industries**













# **Educational Pipeline**

In 2017, there were 47,581 graduates in 4 California Counties. This pipeline has grown by 9% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies, "Business Administration and Management, General", and Biological and Physical Sciences.



## **In-Demand Skills**
