Re-envisioning LMC's Planning Process

**Bringing together all the different plans
and
visionaries to develop
LMC planning processes**

- **Focused Flex 8/9/2017**

The results of the table activity during Focused Flex seemed favorable Planning Option C.

- **Survey Monkey Results 8/28/2017**

Ninety-five (95%) of respondents selected Option C. (42 completed survey; 27 from faculty, 5 from classified staff, and 10 from managers.)

Gathering Input and Feedback

- Focused Flex (discussion and Input from participants)
- Campus-wide survey (emails from Senate Presidents and College President inviting participation)

Starting EMP year-long process in January
2020 (align with the District cycle)

1. Complete the Comprehensive Program Review fall 2017

2. Biennial Program Review Update*

**Program Review occurs every other year except the 5th year following Comprehensive Program Review, in which case it occurs the very next year*

*From Chancellor, California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office:
"Strategic Vision - Letter to the Field 7.21.2017"*

1. Increase by at least 20 percent annually the number of students earning an **associate degree, credential, certificate, or specific skill set**.
2. Increase the number of students who **transfer** to UC and CSU by 35 percent each year.
3. Reduce the average **number of excess credits** accumulated by students who complete their degrees or certificates.
4. Increase the number of students in career education programs who **secure jobs** in their field of study by 15 percent.
5. Close **achievement gaps** once and for all.

CCCCD Strategic Plan

1. Enhance student learning and success
2. Strengthen current and create new partnerships
3. Create a culture of continuous improvement and tangible success
4. Be good stewards of the District's resources
