

Keep students on track with these supports:

- · Ongoing, intrusive advising
- Systems for students to track their progress easily
- Systems/procedures to identify students at risk and provide needed supports
- A structure to redirect students who are not progressing in a program to a more viable path

On/Off Track based on Student's Program Goal

ON TRACK

- 1. Students declare their INTENDED program degree/certificate goal
- Students move toward their INTENDED program degree/certificate goal



OFF TRACK

- 1. Students declare their program degree/certificate goal
- 2. However, their course taking patterns did not support their declared goal.
- 3. The declared goal is not their "REAL" goal.
- 4. Therefor, they are unable to monitor progress towards REAL goal (because the incorrect major was selected and/or never updated)



Research Question (from Dean Benford)

Research Question: What is the percentage of our students who are "off track" from their program?

- 1. How many units did students earn?
- 2. How many students declared in each of the degree/certificate programs? (Students may apply for graduation with the active program listed on file, but are pursuing an alternative program. This results in denial.)
- 3. What are the degree programs that students declared the most?
- 4. Did students' course taking patterns match their program requirements?
 - If they matched, how can we be helpful to support them?
 - If they did not match (course taking patterns did not match their program requirement), what can we do to help them stay on track?


