

Course Enrollment by Modality, Fall 2019




LMC Course Completion and Success Rate by Modality, Fall 2019




LMC Course Completion and Success Rate by Modality, Spring 2020



Course Enrollment by Modality, Fall 2020




LMC Course Completion and Success Rate for Fall 2020

Note: the state Chancellor's Office allowed colleges to extend the withdrawal period as a result of the pandemic. Colleges allowed, and will continue to allow, students to withdraw up until one week before the end of the course. This means that students often know their grade range when making a determination to withdraw from the class. This can result in increased success rates. Additionally, for SP20, all students were automatically granted an Excused Withdrawal and in SP21 and FA21, they did/will receive an EW in instances in which they drop for COVID reasons.
