Dear Colleagues:

In July, the Governor and the Legislature established a new funding formula for the California Community Colleges <u>AB 1809</u>, Chapter 33, Statutes of 2018]. In that Statute, colleges/districts are required to establish the following:

- 1. Local goals that are **aligned with the system-wide goals** in the Vision for Success
- 2. Local goals that are numerically **measurable**
- 3. Local goals that specify the timeline for improvement



## Vision for Success Goals

- Five statewide goals to which colleges and districts must align
- The state chancellor's office has explicitly defined numeric targets for four of the goals each with a five year time horizon
- The baseline year for the goals is 2016/17 and the target year is 2021/22
- There is no state requirement to meet the goals or penalty for not reaching the goals
- On-going problems with the state data dashboards



**GOAL #1** 




Indicator 1c is a black box amalgam of multiple variables and doesn't provide a basis for good planning conversations. Indicators 1a and 1b are both straightforward and it could be argued equally important. We are advising colleges, rather than choose among the two (and thereby suggesting one is more important or preferred), to set goals for both indicators. Increase by 20 percent the number of CCC students annually who acquire associates degrees, credentials, certificates, or specific skill sets that prepare them for an in-demand job.




#### Vision Goal #1a: Increase total degrees by 20% (AS/AA/ADT Degrees)




### Vision Goal #1b: Increase total certificates by 20%









**Indicator 2a** is reliably reported and available in more timely manner than 2b. Furthermore, ADT production is more under the direct control of the colleges than actual transfers **Indicators 2b** is a reliable indicator in terms of data integrity, however, it differs from the transfer definition used in other mandated reports including the ACCJC Annual Report and the new Funding Formula (which include CSUs, UCs, In-state Private Institutions and Out-of-state Universities). To minimize confusion we recommend establishing a goal for 2a only. Note however that we will continue to locally monitor transfers to CSU and UC specifically.

#### **GOAL #2**

Increase by 35 percent the number of CCC students system-wide transferring annually to a UC or CSU.






### Vision Goal #2a: Transfers to UCs and CSUs by 35%




### Vision Goal #2b: ADTs Awarded by 35%








### GOAL #3 ACCUMULATION INDICATOR






