- ARCC: Accountability Reporting for Community Colleges – State-wide report that shows six major performance indicators: progress, achievement, 30 or more unit completion, persistence, vocational and basic skills course completion, ESL and basic skills improvement.
- AS: Academic Senate – Faculty Senate Group
- AVID: Advancement Via Individual Determination
- BOX 2A – Process for allocating new full-time faculty
- CLASS: Course Level Assessment Software System- Tool to assist in course assessment.
- COOR: Course Outline of Record
- CSLO: Course Student Learning Outcomes- stated in course outline of record.
- CTE: Career Technical Education (formerly Occ Ed)
- CUE: Center for Urban Education
- DE: Developmental Education or Distance Education
- EMP: Educational Master Plan - Six-year College strategic plan identifying major goals
- GE: General Education-General Education Criteria for course outlines of record.
- IDEA: Institutional Development for Equity and Access
- ISLO: Institutional Student Learning Outcomes – DE, GE, OE, SS, LLSS
- LLSS: Library and Learning Support Services
- OE or Occ Ed: Occupational Education

- PID: Program Improvement and Development projects that add to, change or create new programs or services
- PRAP: Program Review, Assessment and Planning – Guide for assessing all college programs and program SLOs and planning for the improvement of programs and services
- PSLO: Program Student Learning Outcomes- Program outcomes listed in college catalog.
- RAP: Resource Allocation Process – Process used to allocate College and Perkins IV funds and classified staff
- SGC: Shared Governance Council - Responsible for EMP, RAP, committee charges
- SGC: Shared Governance Council- Represented by all campus groups.
- SLO: Student Learning Outcome – CSLO: Course SLO, PSLO: Program SLO, ISLO: Institutional SLO
- SS: Student Services
- TLP: Teaching and Learning project – Committee developing and implementing SLOs and assessment
