Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Resources:

- Consists of CARES Act (HEERF I), HEERF II, & HEERF III
- Allowable uses:
 - Defraying expenses associated with coronavirus (including lost revenue, reimbursement for expenses already incurred, technology costs associated with a transition to distance education, faculty and staff trainings, and payroll); and
 - Making additional emergency financial aid grants to students.
- LMC utilized RAP, Cabinet, and District processes to identify funding prioritization



HEERF Resources used for the following:

- Campus Safety Operations
 - PPE, enhanced cleaning supplies and equipment (N95/KN95 masks, gloves, and cleaning wipes - all available upon request, please see email sent earlier this week.)
 - Facilities safety equipment (sneeze guards, signage, hand sanitizer dispensers, at home test kits etc.)
 - COVID -19 Surveillance Testing for Student Athletes



- Campus Technology
 - 27 classrooms to be upgraded with new laser projectors and 16x9 wide screens (deployment in progress).
 - OWL systems: smart camera/audio conference devices with tripods. 4 in stock now, 20 ordered (pending delivery).
 - 100 laptop stations: laptops with docking kits, dual monitor setup
 (Deploying). (100 additional laptop stations ordered, pending delivery.)
 - 100 Additional WiFi hotspots. (Ready to be loaned)
 - Expanded WiFi coverage to exterior Parking Lot A in front of library.
 (Deployed and active)



- Campus Technology
 - 50 All in Ones PC systems for podiums, kiosk, and SS student access with social distancing for both campuses. (In progress)
 - 2 additional power charging carts for portable storage of Chromebooks.
 (In progress)
 - 850 LMC student Chromebooks and laptops (Ready). Furniture for storage/support (In progress)
 - Additional LMC employee support reserve of devices. Webcams, digitizers, headsets, speakers, microphones. (Most delivered)



- Campus Technology
 - Outside event technology high lumen laser portable projectors and screens, outdoor AV system, additional portable PA systems. (In progress)
 - Faculty Remote access improvement Art department. Apple Macbook
 Pro systems, new monitors, docks. (In progress)
 - Increased terabyte remote storage devices and network storage for Drama department. (Deployed)

 - Remote cloud management services Design, Implementation, Training
 - Microsoft Intune device management for all LMC Windows systems.
 (In progress)
 - JAMF device management for all LMC Apple devices. (In progress)
 - New Faronics Cloud deploy branch for software management of remote student PC laptops. (Purchased and in setup)
 - Remote Canvas integrated lab software BeyondLabz for LMC.
 (Purchased and on-ramp)
 - 150 remote access virtual desktop infrastructure licenses. (Expansion of 150 seats in progress)



- Additional Supports on Campus
 - Assist the Child Study Center in the transition our instruction to more outdoor activity.
 - Additional class lab equipment to increase remote access to instruction or create a more flexible learning environment
 - New Remote Access Delivery Lockers in Student Union
 - Additional Ocelot Live Agent licenses to implement Ocelot live web chat
 - Additional licenses for Library materials/videos
 - Equipment to support outdoor activities Outdoor Canopies, etc.
 - Outdoor Weight Equipment for Outdoor Classes
