4CD Vaccine Requirement Update

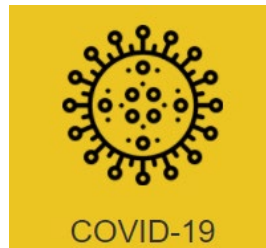
4CD Governing Board Vaccine Requirement Resolution (9/8/21)

To protect the health and safety of students, employees, and members of the community, the Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) requires COVID-19 vaccinations for all employees and for all students taking in-person classes or who need to come to campus for any reason (to access tutoring, student services, the Library, etc.).

4CD Vaccine Requirement Update

As part of the Contra Costa Community College District's ongoing commitment to keep our communities safe, employees are reminded to comply with the following before coming onsite to any District location:

- ❑ Have submitted proof of vaccination or an approved exception
- ❑ Complete a daily health assessment before coming to a 4CD location (have available if requested to show proof)
- ❑ If employees apply for an exception, then they will submit a COVID test result every 7 days before coming onsite
- ❑ Employees are still required to track attendance and District location using the COVID-19 tile on InSite



4CD Vaccine Requirement Update

CCCCD App



Features:

- ❑ Single user authentication utilizing your username and password.
- ❑ Submit proof of vaccination through the home screen, if you haven't already done so.
- ❑ Upload COVID-19 test results (if required because you have an approved exception).
- ❑ Complete your daily health assessment (DHA) to determine whether it is safe for you to come to District locations. You will receive a green or red pass.

4CD Vaccine Requirement Update

Daily Health Assessment (DHA)

- ❑ You **MUST** complete a DHA to visit ANY 4CD location

- ❑ Visitors, students or employees who do not have a smart phone or have not downloaded the CCCCD app, may visit one of our on-campus DHA Verification Stations.
 - PITTSBURG**: 3rd Floor of the Student Services Complex Building

 - BRENTWOOD**: Student Commons

- ❑ Printers are located at the DHA Verification Stations to print out your campus pass and keep with you as proof that you are cleared to be on-site for the day.

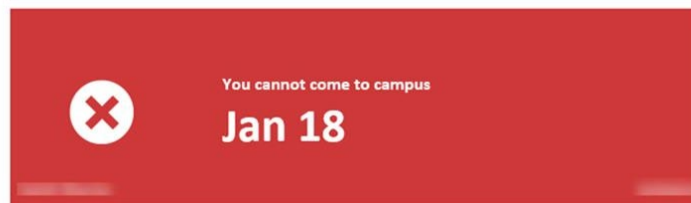

On-Campus

COVID-19 Protocols

As part of LMC's safety measures:



Face coverings or masks are required while on campus in all indoor facilities.



Social distancing is highly recommended.



Daily health assessments are required before visiting campus. Students must complete a health assessment via the CCCCD app to be cleared for attending in-person classes and/or accessing in-person services each day.



Notify your instructor or campus contact if you are not feeling well and stay home.



Wash your hands with warm soap and water for at least 30 seconds or use hand sanitizer.

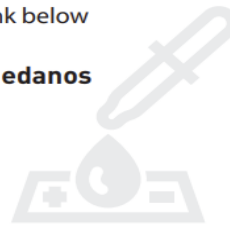

4CD Vaccine Requirement Update

COVID REPORTING

When you become aware of a student or employee COVID exposure or positive COVID test results:

- ❑ Contact your immediate supervisor to inform them of the situation
- ❑ Submit a report to the LMCCOVID@losmedanos.edu listserv
- ❑ Include the following information:
 - Name of person(s) exposed to COVID or receiving positive COVID test results
 - Timeline of exposure and/or date of most recent or projected COVID test
 - Timeline of symptoms (if any)
 - Timeline of presence and/or location on site
