To review and update campus emergency preparedness procedures including but not limited to building monitors and evacuation procedures. 2. To develop an emergency response protocol for managers including establishment of and training for an Emergency Operations Center. 3. To establish and provide training and a communications plan regarding various emergency response situations to all college personnel. 4. To update evacuation signage and procedures, and administer a campus wide evacuation drill (both at the main campus and at the Brentwood campus). 5. To review, recommend, and/or propose solutions for campus safety concerns.</p>
