The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), Disability Advisory Committee (CTDAC) is accepting applications for the 2018 CTDAC scholarships.

This year there will be two scholarships awarded (\$250 each), and each recipient will receive a scholarship certificate.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- A college student who has a disability defined by the Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA) as having a mental or physical impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities.
- A college student residing in California at the time of applying for scholarship.
- Currently enrolled in a minimum of six units in a college or university.

Application and essay questions must be completed on this form, or Word document. Applications will be accepted no later than close of business on **November 16, 2018**.

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on the applicant's answers to the five essay questions. Recipients will be notified by December 7, 2018.
