Eligibility Requirements:

- •Female LMC student transferring to 4-year college/university in Fall 2023
- •Minimum 3.5 GPA
- •Reside in Contra Costa County
- •U.S. Citizen preferred but not required
- •Received minimum of 60 semester units upon graduation from LMC
- •Financial need

Application Requirements:

- 1. Signed AAUW Concord scholarship application (see below)
- 2. Copy of completed LMC scholarship application
- 3. Unofficial LMC transcript
- 4. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a LMC faculty member (LMC professor, instructor, teacher, or academic counselor)

Selection:

•The application deadline is **Thursday, March 16, 2023**. The application and other required documents must be submitted to the LMC Financial Aid Office or emailed to bbui@losmedanos.edu by the deadline.

•AAUW Concord may contact finalists for a Zoom or personal interview.
