Eligibility Requirements:

- Female LMC student transferring to a 4-year college/university in Fall 2021
- Minimum 3.2 GPA
- Reside in Contra Costa County
- Minimum of 55 semester units upon graduation from LMC
- Financial Need

Application Requirements:

- 1. Signed AAUW Delta Contra Costa scholarship application
- 2. Copy of completed LMC scholarship application
- 3. Unofficial LMC transcript
- 4. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a LMC faculty member (LMC professor, instructor, teacher, or academic counselor)

Selection:

- The application deadline is March 20, 2021. The application and other documents must be submitted to the LMC Scholarship Office by email (or as directed by LMC) by the deadline.
- Finalists selected for an interview will be contacted by AAUW Delta Contra Costa.
- Recipients will be invited to attend an AAUW Delta Contra Costa Luncheon TBA.
