Eligibility Requirements:

Applicant must satisfy the following requirements:

- Be an AB 540 student, who does not qualify for federal and/or state financial aid
- The student is not a "green card" recipient
- The student is not a visa holder, of any type
- Must have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.0 and be in good academic standing upon submission of this application.
- Past recipients and applicants are eligible to apply

- To help maintain your privacy, you must create or provide an e-mail address that does not disclose your identity or the identity of the school you are attending, or will be attending.

- Do NOT include your name (first of last) in any part of the application or supporting documents (transcripts with your name are ok), instead use the email address you create.
