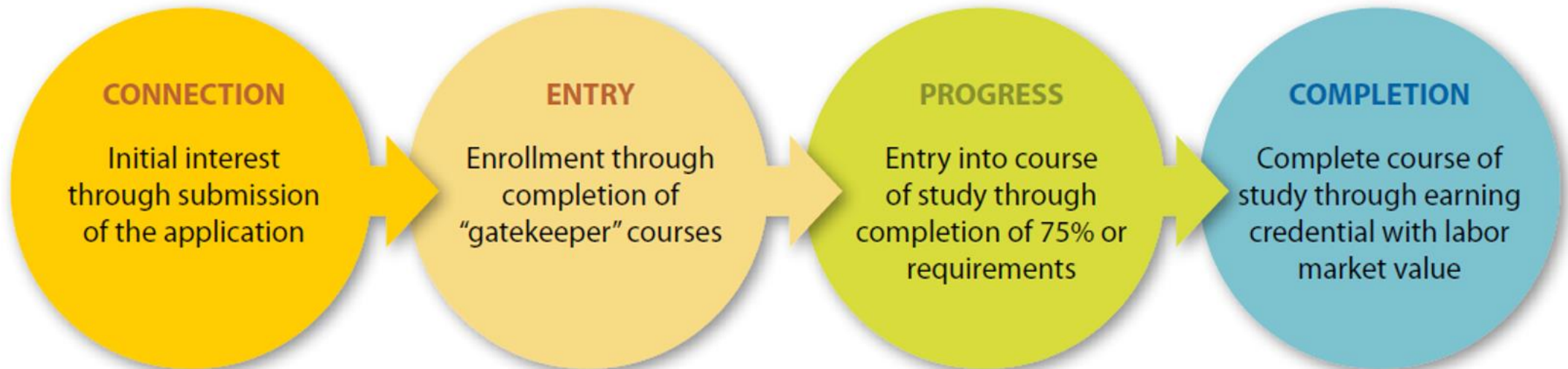

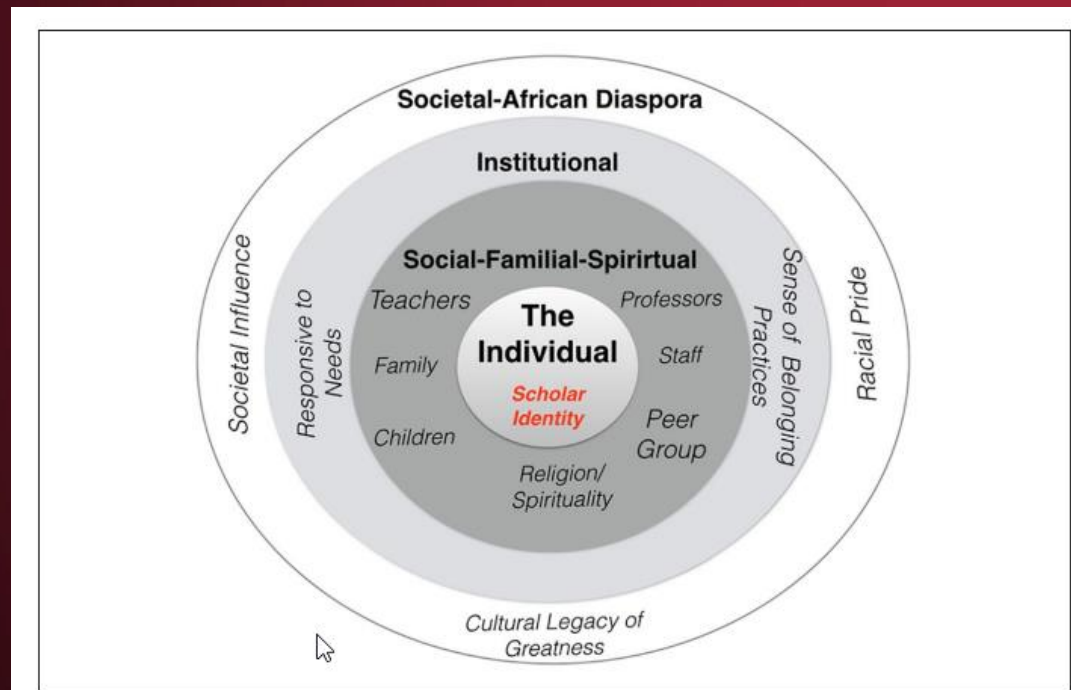
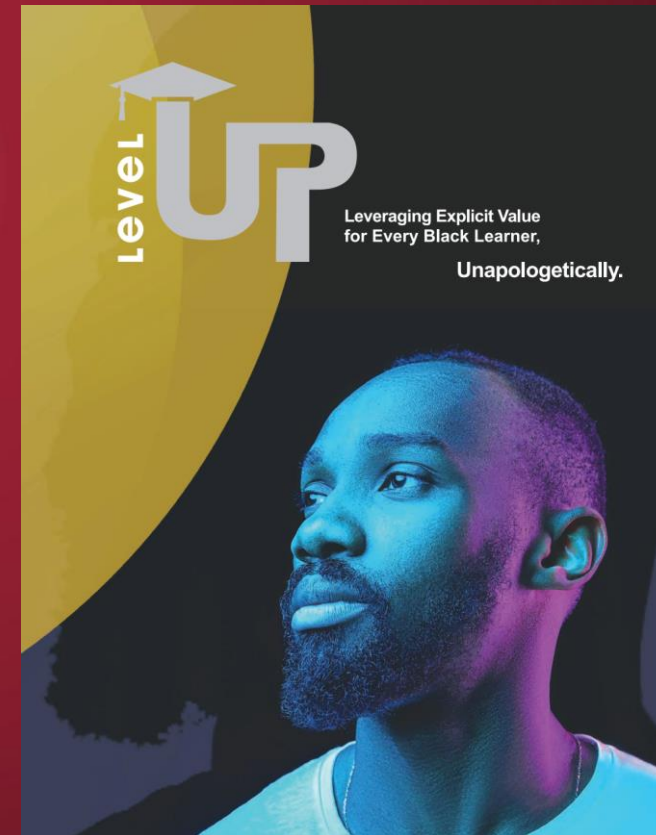


Figure 1. Black male adult learner success theory.
