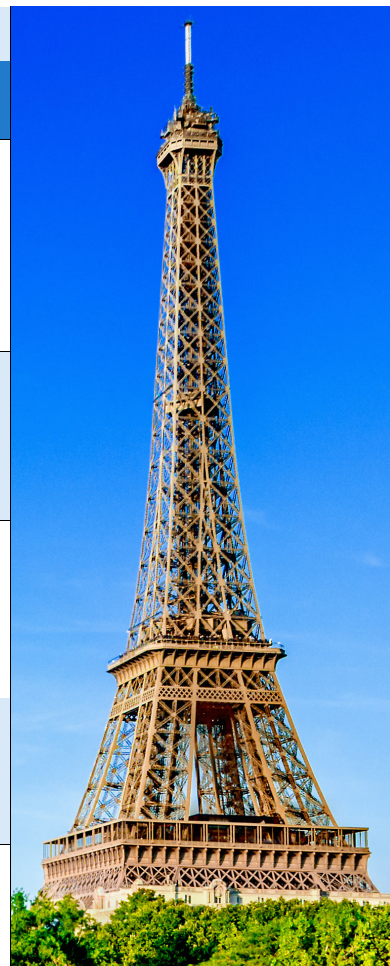

## Base PROGRAM FEE: \$4475 (Twin room)

### The Program Fee Includes:

**Note:** LMC tuition of \$46 per credit unit is not included in the ESA Program Fee. Students are required to enroll in Art 5 for credit with LMC. This 3-unit Cal-GETC/IGETC transferable course costs \$148 for California residents. A Pass/No Pass grade option is available.
