  - Is there a "Repeat Policy/Penalty" for repeating Nursing prerequisites?
  - Is there a "Recency" requirement for Nursing prerequisites (example must have been completed within the past 5 years)?
  - Is there a maximum number of attempts for the TEAS Exam? What is the minimum/average TEAS Score for admitted students?
  - When do all Nursing prerequisites need to be completed by? What is the minimum/average GPA for admitted students?
