TRANSFER ADMISSIONS GUARANTEE (TAG) AGREEMENT

Between

NORFOLK STATE UNIVERSITY

and

LOS MEDANOS COLLEGE

Norfolk State University (hereinafter referred to as NSU) and Los Medanos College (herein referred as LMC) enter into the following agreement governing the matriculation at NSU. Beginning Fall Semester 2014 and continuing until either party decides to dissolve the agreement notifies the other in writing that it desires to dissolve the agreement, and the parties approve a mutually acceptable dissolution plan.

During the period of this agreement, NSU will:

Accept students who have completed a minimum of 12 transferable semester units with an overall 2.0 or higher grade point average.

- a. Only transfer credit which includes courses in which a grade of "C" or better was earned will be accepted.
- b. Student has completed the agreed upon courses that are deemed by NSU to be equivalent to NSU courses.
- c. Student understands that he/she may need to complete additional prerequisites as required by the programs in which he/she enrolls at NSU.

During the period of this agreement, LMC will:

- 1. Publicize the agreement among its sudents and faculty and identify potential students who would benefit from this articulation agreement;
- 2. Make available to prospective transfer students, through early advisement sessions, information and requirements for admission to NSU, a list of general education NSU courses and the equivalent courses at LMC.

Both NSU and LMC will:

- 1. Monitor the academic performance of students enrolling under this agreement, identify problems, and work cooperatively to facilitate the seamless transfer of students between NSU and LMC and
- 2. Notify each other of any curricular changes relevant to this agreement in a timely manner.

Governing law: This Agreement is governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Norfolk State University Course Articulation Agreement with Los Medanos College General Education Advisory Tool

Norfolk State University will accept courses from the IGETC (Inter-segmental General Education Transfer Curriculum) pattern as part of their general education core. CONDITIONS TO SIGN A (NSU) TAG AGREEMENT

- The TAG deadline for the fall semester is March 30th (the fall NSU application is May 15th) and the TAG deadline for the spring semester is September 1st (the spring application deadline is October 1st).
- TAG agreements may be made for NSU only after the student has completed six transferrable units and completed or are currently enrolled in a transferrable Math class (Math 34 or above) or one level below transferrable Math (Math 30 or 26) and completed or are currently enrolled in transferrable English (English 100) or are currently in one level below college level English (English 90).
- To enter into a TAG agreement make a counseling appointment at the counseling front counter and be sure to mention that you would like to enter into a TAG agreement.
- Make an appointment with the Financial Aid Office to secure a package.
- Please note that students may need to complete additional prerequisites as required by the programs which he/she enrolls at NSU.

This agreement is valid only for the term checked above. If a later term of entry is desired, a new TAG must be completed.

NORFOLK STATE TAG Agreement Student Process

Visit the Transfer Center (CC2-225) or <u>www.losmedanos.edu/transfer</u> and pick up TAG agreement.
Make an appointment with your assigned program counselor (ex: Umoja) or the Transfer Counselor who will analyze your transcripts to ensure you have met the minimum requirements to enter into a TAG with <u>Norfolk State University</u> .
If you meet the minimum requirements, you and your LMC counselor must sign the agreement.
No later than March 30th for fall admissions and September 1st for spring admissions; return the agreement to the Transfer Center Coordinator, who will email your contract to Norfolk State Admissions.
Upon approval Norfolk State Admissions will send an email reply to Transfer Center Coordinator , who will forward you the approval via email. This may take up to 8 weeks.
Submit the Norfolk State application online no later than May 15th for fall admission and October 1 st for spring admission. (Your application fee will be waived.)
Norfolk State Admissions will notify you of their acceptance and further instructions on scholarships and housing applications.
Visit the LMC Scholarship Office for information on grants and scholarships you may be eligible for. Upon acceptance, update your FAFSA (visit Financial Aid office for more information).

NORFOLK STATE TAG Agreement Staff Process

Student picks up TAG agreement from Transfer Center or website and makes an appointment with their assigned program counselor (ex: Umoja) or the Transfer Counselor who analyzes their transcripts to ensure they have met the minimum requirements to enter into a TAG with Norfolk State University.
No later than March 30th for fall admissions and September 1st for spring admissions; student and LMC counselor sign the agreement and return it to Transfer Center Coordinator, who then emails the student contract to Norfolk State Admissions.
Upon approval Norfolk State Admissions will send an email reply to Transfer Center Coordinator, who then forwards the approval to the student.
The Transfer Center Coordinator will email Norfolk State Admissions with a list of students applying online.
Student will submit the Norfolk State application online no later than May 15th for fall admission and October 1st for spring admission.
Norfolk State Admissions notifies student of their acceptance and further instructions on scholarships and housing applications.
