
Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

- Guaranteed transfer admission for California Community College Students
- Six participating campuses:
 - UC Davis
 - UC Irvine
 - UC Merced
 - UC Riverside
 - ▶ UC Santa Barbara
 - ▶ UC Santa Cruz

Who Can TAG?

YES	NO
CA Community College Student (including AB540 and International Students with visa)	If already in possession of Bachelor's, Graduate, or other professional degree
Completed at least 30 transferrable semester units	Students who have previously enrolled at the same UC campus they're TAGing to (not including summer session or cross-enrollment)

Fall 2018 TAGs- answers to common questions

- You can submit a TAG to only ONE UC, but can apply to as many as you like
 - ▶ UC's accepting TAG: Davis, Irvine, Merced, Riverside, Santa Barbara, Santa Cruz
 - ▶ UC's only accepting regular applications: UC Berkeley, Los Angeles, San Diego
- You MUST submit a regular UC application after a TAG, even if it's approved
- You should still apply for TAG if your GPA is slightly under minimum eligibility
 - ▶ It's free, the same amount of work, and why not?
- Both a TAG application and Regular UC application must be submitted for TAG to be valid
 - ▶ The major must be the same if the same school
- ► TAG is NOT a Binding Contract- you can sign a TAG, but still attend another campus

Minimum Admission Requirements for UC

- ► To be considered for UC admission as a Junior, you must fulfill the following:
 - Complete 60 semester (90 quarter) units of UC transferable college credit with a GPA of at least 2.4*
 - ► Two transferable college courses in English composition (ENGL 100 and 221/230)
 - One transferable college course in mathematical concepts and quantitative reasoning (MATH 34+)
 - Four transferable college courses chosen from at least two of the following areas:
 - Arts & Humanities
 - Social & Behavioral Sciences
 - ► Physical & Biological Sciences

*** At least 60 UC transferable units must be completed by the end of Spring for Fall Transfer ***

TAG- Unit Requirements

- ► To submit a TAG, all applicants must have completed 30 transferable units **before Fall 2017**
 - 60 transferable units must be completed by the end of Spring2018
- Exceptions: UC Santa Barbara does not include AP/IB units, and requires 30 units completed in residence at community college

How to Pursue TAG


- 1. Fill out the Transfer Admission Planner (TAP)
- 2. Complete the online TAG application via TAP (September 1-30)
- 3. Review application with academic counselor
- 4. Fulfill all remaining coursework and GPA requirements in your TAG agreements
- 5. Apply for admission to UC (separate application from TAG, application open August 1-November 30, submission period November 1-30)






Please be sure you have done a thorough search before adding!

Non-transferrable, Non-CCC coursework

- Non-transferrable courses and any course from other colleges will not appear through search
- Courses must be added manually, EXACTLY as it appears on transcripts
- ► Enter subject, course #, title, grade earned, units received

Gaps and Repeats in Coursework

- Report ALL gaps in education
- Make sure you add your D's and F's when you received them. When you add the course repeated, it will reflect that in TAP



AP and IB credit
