- 3. Umoja Scholars are required to meet with the Umoja Scholars Counselor 2-3 times per semester to discuss educational and career goals, and to seek advice on academic and personal success.
- 4. Make use of LMC Student Services: If eligible, apply for Financial Aid (FAFSA), EOPS, BOEP, CalWorks and/or DSPS, and visit the Transfer & Career Services and Student Life.
- 5. Communicate with Umoja Scholars students, staff, and faculty as much as necessary to achieve academic success.
- 6. Attend tutoring and study group sessions when offered.
- 7. Keep your CURRENT contact information on file at ALL times: phone, address, and email.
- 8. Attend at least one college tour per year.
- 9. Visit the Umoja Village (Student Union room 221) as much as possible.
- 10. Participate and be actively involved in at least 3 Umoja activities per semester: Community Meetings, Umoja Leadership Collective (ULC) club activities, workshops, etc.
